Air France serves the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area primarily through Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD). The airline does not operate a public walk-in ticket office in downtown Washington, D.C. Passenger services are available at airport counters and through official phone and online support channels.

Air France operates from the main international terminal (Terminal A/B area depending on gate assignment) at Washington Dulles International Airport. The airport handles both domestic and international flights, with Air France primarily operating long-haul international services.

Washington Dulles serves as the primary gateway for Air France passengers traveling between the U.S. capital region and Europe, particularly Paris.

There is no separate city-center Air France office in Washington, D.C. For ticketing, check-in, baggage support, or urgent travel matters, passengers should visit the airline's airport counters or use official customer support channels.

Operations in the Washington, D.C. Area

Washington Dulles International Airport serves as Air France's operational hub in the D.C. region. The airline typically operates direct long-haul flights between Washington Dulles and Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport.

Air France does not operate scheduled services from these airports. Its Washington-area operations are based exclusively at Washington Dulles International Airport.

- At least 3 hours before scheduled international departures
- Earlier during peak travel periods or holiday seasons
