Located in the Paris region, the headquarters is where key strategic, commercial, and operational decisions are made for the global Air France network. The headquarters is not a public walk-in ticketing office for passengers; customer services are handled through airport counters, official phone lines, and online channels.

Functions of the Headquarters

Air France Headquarters is responsible for overseeing core strategic and operational functions, including:

- Corporate governance and executive leadership
- Commercial planning and network strategy
- Finance, accounting, and budgeting
- Customer experience and service policy
- Global marketing and brand management
- Safety oversight and regulatory compliance
- Fleet planning and aircraft procurement
- Human resources and organizational development
- Legal, corporate affairs, and government relations

The headquarters also collaborates closely with partner airlines (including KLM and other members of the SkyTeam alliance) on global operations, codeshare networks, and loyalty programs.

Customer service for reservations, ticketing, baggage issues, refunds, and travel changes are handled through airport counters or official support channels, not through the corporate headquarters facility.

International Presence

In addition to the main headquarters in France, Air France maintains regional offices and representation worldwide to support sales, corporate accounts, cargo operations, sales partners, and local business development. These offices vary by region and often provide localized support for travel agents and corporate clients.

Travel and Security Access Notes

- The headquarters location near Charles de Gaulle Airport is primarily a corporate facility and is not open to general passenger walk-in service.
 - Visits to the headquarters require prior authorization or business appointments with corporate departments.
 - Passenger inquiries related to bookings or travel support should use official airline channels at airports or online.
